Jharkhand: Amendment to the EC granted on 10.12.2008 for expansion of 0.9
MTPA to 5.00 MTPA coal washery.

Sir,

This is with reference to letter no. MDCL/HO/JPL/72 dated 27.11.2012 with the request for amendment to the conditions in the Environment Clearance (EC) granted by this Ministry's letter vide no. J-11015/260/2008-IA.II (M) dated 10.12.2008. Reference is also invited to the letter no. MDCL/HO/JPL/72 dated 19.2.2013 in this regard.

2. The Ministry of Environment & Forests has considered the application. The proposal was considered in the 67th Expert Appraisal Committee held on 4th -5th February, 2013. It is noted that the proposal is for amendment to the EC dated 10.12.2008 grant of Environmental Clearance for M/s Monnet Daniels Coal Washeries Pvt. Ltd. at Karanpura, Ranchi, Jharkhand. The proponent informed that:

- i. M/S Monnet Daniels Coal Washeries Pvt. Ltd. was accorded Environmental Clearance for setting up 5 MTPA Coal Washery at KDH OCP of Central Coalfields Ltd. in Village Karanpura, Distt. Ranchi (Jharkhand) vide MoEF letter No. J-11015/260/2008-IA.II(M) dated 10.12.2008.
- ii. M/S Monnet Daniels Coal Washeries Pvt. Ltd. vide its letter no. of vide proponent letter no. MDCL/HO/JPL/72 dated 27.11.2012 MDCL/HO/JPL/72 dated 27.11.2012 and MDCL/HO/JPL/72 dated 19.2.2013 has requested for amendment to the EC viz. (i) any surplus rejects to go to FBC based thermal power plants by rail with whom they have long term MOU and typographical correction in the EC at specific condition no. x at page 2 be rectified from 3 MTPA to 1 MTPA.
- iii. The Coal is being washed for Punjab State Electricity Board under contractual agreement. As per the EC, the rejects generated will be used by Monnet Ispat & Energy Ltd.(MIEL) at it's power plant at Raigarh. M/S Monnet Ispat & Energy Ltd. has 170 MW (240 TPH AFBC & 336 TPH CFBC Boilers) Power Plant situated at Raigarh in Chhattisgarh, which is using rejects from the washery.
- iv. The reason for amendment to the EC, as mentioned by Monnet Ispat & Energy Ltd. (MIEL), Raigarh that it is having an installed capacity of 5 Lakh Tonne Sponge Iron. Further, expansion of 2 Lakh Tonne is under progress and thereafter, the total capacity of Sponge Iron manufacturing will be 7 Lakh Tonne.
- v. Presently, MIEL is generating 32.5 MW power from WHRB and after expansion MIEL will be in a position to generate approx. 50 MW power from WHRB itself. MIEL can meet its power demand from WHRB.

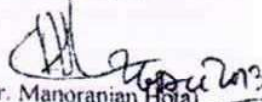

- vi. Generation of power from WHRB is more eco-friendly as well as economical. Zero fly ash generation from waste heat recovery boiler (WHRB). Eliminates fly ash disposal. Presently, low demand of power in the market.
- vii. Parties interested to purchase rejects for use in their TPPS are Gupta Energy Pvt. Ltd., Hindalco Industries Ltd., Disergarh Power, Jaypee Cement, Shree Bhageshwari Papers Ltd., Silverton Pulp & Papers Pvt. Ltd., NS Papers Ltd., Sidheshwari Papers Udyog Ltd., India Glycols Ltd., Nector Life & Science Ltd., Jubilant Organosys Science Active, Sumit Agro Products Ltd. and Other Users.
- viii. Based on the various reasons as mentioned above, the August Committee is requested to allow us disposal/sale of washery rejects to other users also so that the entire rejects could be disposed of smoothly.
- ix. Copy of each such MOU has been submitted by the proponent to MoEF.

3. The 67th Expert Appraisal Committee in its meeting held on 4th -5th February, 2013 had considered the proposal and recommended for amendment to the Environment Clearance dated 10.12.2008 with that for any surplus rejects to go to FBC based thermal power plants by rail with whom they have long term MOU and typographical correction in the EC at specific condition no. (x) at page 2 be rectified from 3 MTPA to 1 MTPA. Based on the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC), the Ministry Environment & Forest here with amends the EC, granted vide no. No. J-11015/260/2008-IA.II(M) dated 10.12.2008 for any surplus rejects to go to FBC based thermal power plants by rail with whom they have long term MOU and typographical correction in the EC at specific condition no. x at page 2 is corrected from "3" MTPA to "1" MTPA with the following specific conditions:

- i. After fulfilling the requirements of Monnet Ispat & Energy Ltd.'s 170 MW (240 TPH AFBC & 336 TPH CFBC Boilers) Power Plant situated at Raigarh in Chhattisgarh, any surplus rejects shall go to FBC based thermal power plants by rail with whom they have long term MOU.
- ii. The typographic error at sl no. (x) under the specific condition at page 2 of EC letter no. J-11015/260/2008-IA.II(M) dated 10.12.2008 as requested by the proponent is corrected from "3" MTPA to "1" MTPA.

4. All other conditions, as stipulated in the letter no. J-11015/260/2008-IA.II(M) dated 10.12.2008, remains unchanged.
